Hokkaido University Ambassador and Partner System

To make Hokkaido University better known internationally and build a global network, we have appointed Hokkaido University Ambassadors who will play a central role in supporting HU in their country or region, and Hokkaido University Partners who will take a more flexible role and support our Ambassadors.

Our ambassadors and partners will provide support and cooperation for HU in activities to expand and enliven Hokkaido University communities, particularly overseas.

Ambassadors may carry out activities as follows:

- Building a local network
- Supporting local students wishing to study at HU and HU students wishing to study overseas
- Supporting HU-affiliated persons visiting local areas
- Development of local internship sites, etc.

Partners may carry out activities as follows:

- Supporting local students wishing to study at HU and HU students wishing to study overseas
- Supporting HU-affiliated persons visiting local areas
- Distributing information about HU in local languages using social media, etc.
- Providing support for local events such as HU presentations
- Supporting ambassadors' activities

Q: How long are the ambassadors' and partners' terms?

A: Ambassadors' terms last for three years and can be renewed as many times as desired. Partners' terms are indefinite.

Q: Are ambassador and partner activities voluntary?

A: They are voluntary as a rule, but remuneration for cooperation with faculties may be paid by faculties for certain projects. Ambassadors and partners also receive badges when they are appointed, as well as any necessary resources for their activities, such as business cards and informational materials to hand out.

Q: I may not be able to participate on some occasions due to work; will this be an issue?

A: No, it will not be an issue at all. Ambassadors and partners can participate as much as they are able. Parties such as faculties request cooperation from ambassadors and partners through the Global Relations Team. Ambassadors and partners may decline the request if it is not possible for them or if the activity will be difficult due to local circumstances.

Q: Are there any things that ambassadors and partners must do?

A: Ambassadors and partners must submit a basic report on the year's activities at the end of each academic year.
