



Education Partnerships

Education partnerships that are implemented by ITS consist of:

- Teaching and Non teaching staffs exchange program;
- Student and staff mobilization program;
- Curriculum development program in higher education system that covers science, technology and/or arts;
- Collaborations for advance studies for all Academic Community and Alumni;
- Collaboration in professional education and skills trainings.



Research Partnerships

Research partnerships cover:

- c. Research of Higher Education grant
- d. Research from other Ministries grants
- e. Research from Central/local government research funds
- f. Research from Private sector research funds
- g. Research from Overseas partnership research funds
- f. Research from other resources funded by community



Community Service Partnerships

Community service partnerships cover:

- Partnerships in training, counselling, applied skill education for public;
- Partnership in capacity building and potential empowerment for the people in the remote and underdeveloped areas;
- Partnership in the social and economy development of community;
- Partnership in the implementation of CSR Program for business units
- ❖ Other community service partnerships, as a part of consortium in self management project applied by the local government or other state owned government enterprises (such as BUMN / BUMD)


- Land utilization partnerships;




