Sustainability Weeks is an event hosted by Hokkaido University with the aim of promoting research and education to help create a sustainable society.

## History

The first such session was organized in 2007, and it has since been held every year with the involvement of the entire university.

## Participants

The event will see an assembly of 10,000 researchers, educators, students, and citizens from home and abroad sharing and discussing the latest scientific knowledge at international symposiums, public seminars, and various exhibitions.

The event will cover almost all of the academic disciplines relevant to the discussion of a sustainable society including climate change, biodiversity, health, quality of life, renewable energy, disaster prevention and sustainability education.
