New COVID-19 Case Confirmed at Hokkaido University

Hokkaido University confirmed a new COVID-19 case among its students on Tuesday, April 6.

We tracked the patient's recent movements on campus and traced the patient's contact history through a personal interview. Those identified as close contacts are now mandated to stay at home and undertake physical health monitoring for 14 days from the last date of exposure.

We wish a rapid recovery for the patient while committing ourselves to safeguarding our University community from COVID-19 outbreaks.
