

New COVID-19 Cases Confirmed at Hokkaido University

Hokkaido University confirmed two new COVID-19 cases among its students and one among its staff members between Sunday, May 23 and Wednesday, June 9.

We tracked their recent movements on campus and traced their contact history through personal interviews. Those identified as close contacts are now mandated to stay at home and undertake physical health monitoring for 14 days from the last date of exposure.

We wish a rapid recovery for the students while committing ourselves to safeguarding our University community from COVID-19 outbreaks.
