Cluster of COVID-19 Cases Identified at Hokkaido University

Nine students in a student extracurricular group of the University tested positive in a cluster of COVID-19 cases between Friday, July 30th and Tuesday, August 3rd. Subsequently, their close contacts within the University community were identified by tracking their movement history on campus, and those identified have been placed under stay-at-home order and monitoring their health for 14 days after their last exposure to the infected person.

We wish those infected a speedy recovery while committing ourselves further to preventing the spread of COVID-19.
