

[Update] Cluster of COVID-19 Cases Identified at Hokkaido University

As you may know, we have previously reported a cluster of COVID-19 cases identified in a student extracurricular group of the University on August 5th, 2021. Subsequently, three additional students tested positive between Thursday, August 5th and Tuesday, August 10. The total number of confirmed cases in this cluster is 12.

Their close contacts within the University community were identified by tracking their movement history on campus, and those identified have been placed under stay-at-home order and monitoring their health for 14 days after the last exposure to the infected person(s).

We wish those infected a speedy recovery while committing ourselves further to preventing the spread of COVID-19.

Note: The University requests that patient and family privacy and confidentiality be maintained in all forms of communication by all concerned, and their human rights be protected at all times.
