

New COVID-19 Cases Confirmed at Hokkaido University

Hokkaido University confirmed four new COVID-19 cases among its students between Sunday, August 8 and Friday, August 20.

Subsequently, their close contacts within the University community were identified by tracking their movement history on campus, and those identified have been placed under stay-at-home order and monitoring health for 14 days after their last exposure to the infected person.

We wish those infected a speedy recovery while committing ourselves further to preventing the spread of COVID-19.
