New COVID-19 Cases Confirmed at Hokkaido University

Hokkaido University confirmed twelve new COVID-19 cases among its students and one case of a staff member between Saturday, January 22 and Friday, January 28.

Subsequently, their close contacts within the University community were identified by tracking their movement history on campus, and those identified have been ordered to stay home for 7 days and monitor their health for 10 days after their last exposure to the infected person.

We wish those infected a speedy recovery while committing ourselves further to preventing the spread of COVID-19.

Note: The University requests that patient and family privacy and confidentiality be maintained in all forms of communication by all concerned, and their human rights be protected at all times.
