5	Schedule	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. HU students apply to the Global Economist Program after passing the entrance exam, apply for their preferred placement by early April, are selected by the end of April, and get approval from Yonsei by May. 2. Take Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, and Econometrics in the first semester of the first year. 3. Enroll in Yonsei from March to December in the second year, take courses and write a master's thesis based on the study plan agreed upon by both universities. 4. Return to Hokkaido University in December of the second year. 5. Thesis examinations are in December at Yonsei and in January at HU. 6. Credit transfer measures are implemented, so it is possible to complete the program within the standard period of study (two years at Hokkaido University).
