7	Cost	HU will waive fees for entrance examinations, admission and tuition. RMIT will provide a tuition fee scholarship for eligible candidates for up to a maximum of 3.5 years. RMIT will provide a stipend scholarship for up to a maximum of 12 months, for enrolled candidates while in Melbourne, at the applicable annual rate.
