NTU is Taiwan's top university, and its predecessor is the former Taipei Imperial University, which was founded in 1928. NTU (economics) is one of the most important school-level partner of HU (economics).

4	Eligibility	1. English score (TOEFL-iBT80, IELTS6.0, TOEIC730), 2. HU students should complete Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Econometrics at Hokkaido University, 3. A master's thesis in English
5	Schedule	1. HU students apply to the Global Economist Program after passing the entrance exam, apply for their preferred placement by early April, are selected by the end of April, and get approval from NTU by May. 2. Take Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, and Econometrics in the first semester of the first year. 3. Enroll in NTU for the second semester of the first year and the first semester of the second year, take courses and write a master's thesis based on the study plan agreed upon by both universities. 4. Return to Hokkaido University for the second semester of the second year. 5. Thesis examinations are in July at NTU and in January at HU. 6. Credit transfer measures are implemented, so it is possible to complete the program within the standard period of study (two years at Hokkaido University).
