The applicant must have a doctoral degree on the date of appointment

From the starting date (on or after October 1, 2026) through March 31, 2027

Renewal of the contract may be possible. It will be determined at the end of the contract period based on factors such as workload, work performance, and the availability of funds. The total period of employment may not exceed three years from the initial date of appointment.
